1. If you want pay, report to Bldg. #174, Disbursing Office, at 0800.
2. After you have been paid, report to Classification Center, top
side, Bldg. #221. NOTE: CB's do not report to Classification
Center. CB's changed to General Service do report.
3. Purchase your railroad ticket from Ship's Service, south lobby,
Bldg. #221, after you have been cleared through the Classifica-
tion Center. Make no reservation for earlier than 1400 of day you
are to leave.
4. Remove your gear from Bldg. #218 and ship it home. (Exception:
If you are returning to this Receiving Ship, leave your gear
in 218.) You may ship 150 pounds free on your railroad ticket.
A Railway Express Agency is also located on the east platform
of Bldg. #221.
5. Present this chit and the chit you will receive at the Classifica-
tion Center to Window 27 for liberty.

ON THIS DATE

AUG 15 1945

DO THIS:

1. Pick up your leave-transfer papers at the Reporting-Out Desk,
on the Seaward side of Bldg. #173 ("E"). In order to get these
papers you must show three things:
(A) A transportation ticket (if your address is outside this
area).
(B) An outgoing baggage check (or certification from watch
officer that gear is not on this station).
(C) Your chit from the Classification Center.

BUT NOTE:

If you are returning to this Receiving Ship upon the expiration
of your leave, pick up leave papers at leave window, north
lobby of Bldg. #221.

In order to get these papers you must show three things:

- (A) A transportation ticket (if your address is outside this
area).
- (B) A baggage check from Bldg. #218, showing your gear is
checked there.
- (C) Your chit from the Classification Center.

Note: Be in regulation dress blues. No orders issued to men
needing shaves or haircuts.
